Count One Unauthorized Use of Computer, Cable or Telecommunications Property - F5 §2913.04(B)
<p><i>The jurors of the Grand Jury of the State of Ohio, within and for the body of Ottawa County, on their oaths, IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF OHIO, do find and present:</i></p> <p>Kent Johnson, on or about September 1, 2022 through September 30, 2022, at the county of Ottawa aforesaid, did in any manner and by any means, including, but not limited to, computer hacking, knowingly gain access to, attempt to gain access to, or cause access to be gained to any computer, computer system, computer network, cable service, cable system, telecommunications device, telecommunications service, or information service without the consent of, or beyond the scope of the express or implied consent of, the owner of the computer, computer system, computer network, cable service, cable system, telecommunications device, telecommunications service, or information service or other person authorized to give consent in violation of Ohio Revised Code §2913.04(B), Unauthorized Use of Computer, Cable or Telecommunications Property, F5.</p> <p><i>The offense is contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.</i></p>

Count Two

Voyeurism - M1
§2907.08(D), 2907.08(E)(4)

The grand jurors, on their oaths, further find and present that:

Kent Johnson, on or about September 1, 2022 through September 30, 2022, at the county of Ottawa aforesaid, did secretly or surreptitiously videotape, photograph, film, or otherwise record [REDACTED] under or through the clothing worn by her, for the purpose of viewing [REDACTED] body or undergarments in violation of Ohio Revised Code §2907.08(D), 2907.08(E)(4), **Voyeurism, M1.**

The offense is contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

Count Three

Interfering with Civil Rights - M1
§2921.45(A), 2921.45(B)

The grand jurors, on their oaths, further find and present that:

Kent Johnson, on or about September 1, 2022 through October 30, 2022, at the county of Ottawa aforesaid, did while being a public servant, under color of his office, employment, or authority, knowingly deprive or conspire or attempt to deprive any person of a constitutional or statutory right in violation of Ohio Revised Code §2921.45 (A), 2921.45(B), **Interfering with Civil Rights, M1.**

The offense is contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

Count Four

Menacing by Stalking - M1
§2903.211(A)(1), 2903.211(B)(1)

The grand jurors, on their oaths, further find and present that:

Kent Johnson, on or about October 1, 2022 through May 31, 2023, at the county of Ottawa aforesaid, by engaging in a pattern of conduct, did knowingly cause [REDACTED] believe that Kent Johnson will cause physical harm to [REDACTED] cause mental distress to [REDACTED] violation of Ohio Revised Code §2903.211(A)(1), 2903.211(B)(1), **Menacing by Stalking, M1.**



Count Five	Telecommunications Harassment - M1 §2917.21(A)(2)
<p><i>The grand jurors, on their oaths, further find and present that:</i></p> <p>Kent Johnson, on or about September 1, 2022 through May 31, 2023, at the county of Ottawa aforesaid, knowingly make or cause to be made a telecommunication, or knowingly permit a telecommunication to be made from a telecommunications device under the person's control, to another, and the caller described, suggested, requested, or proposed that the caller, the recipient of the telecommunication, or any other person engage in sexual activity, and the recipient or another person at the premises to which the telecommunication was made had requested, in a previous telecommunication or in the immediate telecommunication, that the caller not make a telecommunication to the recipient or to the premises to which the telecommunication was made in violation of Ohio Revised Code §2917.21(A)(2), Telecommunications Harassment, M1.</p> <p><i>The offense is contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.</i></p>	
Count Six	Theft in Office - F4 §2921.41(A)(1), 2921.41(B)
<p><i>The grand jurors, on their oaths, further find and present that:</i></p> <p>Kent Johnson, on or about January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2022, at the county of Ottawa aforesaid, did, while being a public or party official, commit any theft offense, as defined in division (K) of section 2913.01 of the Revised Code, when the offender used the offender's office in aid of committing the offense or permitted or assented to its use in aid of committing the offense and the value of property or services stolen was one thousand dollars or more and was less than seven thousand five hundred dollars in violation of Ohio Revised Code §2921.41(A)(1), 2921.41(B), Theft in Office, F4.</p> <p><i>The offense is contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.</i></p>	
Count Seven	Gross Sexual Imposition - F4 §2907.05(A)(1)
<p><i>The grand jurors, on their oaths, further find and present that:</i></p> <p>Kent Johnson, on or about July 1, 2022 through July 30, 2022, at the county of Ottawa aforesaid, did have sexual contact with another, not his spouse, by purposely compelling said other person to submit by force or threat of force in violation of Ohio Revised Code §2907.05(A)(1), Gross Sexual Imposition, F4.</p> <p><i>The offense is contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.</i></p>	

Count Eight	Gross Sexual Imposition - F4 §2907.05(A)(1)
<p><i>The grand jurors, on their oaths, further find and present that:</i></p> <p>Kent Johnson, on or about October 1, 2022 through October 31, 2022, at the county of Ottawa aforesaid, did have sexual contact with another, not his spouse, by purposely compelling said other person to submit by force or threat of force in violation of Ohio Revised Code §2907.05(A)(1), Gross Sexual Imposition, F4.</p> <p><i>The offense is contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.</i></p>	
Count Nine	Intimidation of an Attorney, Victim or Witness in a Criminal Case - M1 §2921.04(A), 2921.04(D)
<p><i>The grand jurors, on their oaths, further find and present that:</i></p> <p>Kent Johnson, on or about October 1, 2022 through May 31, 2023, at the county of Ottawa aforesaid, did knowingly attempt to intimidate or hinder the victim of a crime in the filing or prosecution of criminal charges or a witness involved in a criminal action or proceeding in the discharge of the duties of the witness in violation of Ohio Revised Code §2921.04(A), 2921.04(D), Intimidation of an Attorney, Victim or Witness in a Criminal Case, M1.</p> <p><i>The offense is contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.</i></p>	
Count Ten	Theft - M1 §2913.02(A)(1)
<p><i>The grand jurors, on their oaths, further find and present that:</i></p> <p>Kent Johnson, on or about September 1, 2022, at the county of Ottawa aforesaid, did, with purpose to deprive the owner, of cell phone pictures, knowingly obtain or exert control over either the property or services without the consent of the owner or person authorized to give consent in violation of Ohio Revised Code §2913.02(A)(1), Theft, M1.</p> <p><i>The offense is contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.</i></p>




